2009 Neighborhood Stabilization Amendment I
to the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development

Franklin County will submit a first amendment to its 2009 Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) to the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD). The County's Consolidated Plan states that any substantial change to NSP requires a formal amendment to HUD. A substantial change is defined as the addition of any new project, the cancellation of any approved project, a change to the approved location of a project, a major change in the scope of activities of any project or its beneficiaries, or the increase or decrease of funding to a project in excess of 20%.

This first amendment to the 2009 Action Plan is required because the County proposes to add a project to its program, while deleting two others (the projects are being deleted because they failed to secure the state tax credits necessary to assure their completion.)
