## A Vision for the Future

In the first public meeting, we decided on visions for the future:



Enhance small-town character.

Create strong community.



Housing for **everyone**.



Safety for all modes of travel.



Enough space for active lifestyles.

# What is a plan? Why do we need one? Who is impacted?

A community plan is a document that will guide the Village's future decisions on how land is used, where new parks are created, and how buildings are designed. It will guide where sidewalks, bike paths, and other roadway infrastructure is built.

Therefore, the plan is needed to give all of Urbancrest's community members a voice in the future.

The planning process is your opportunity to ensure that **your** priorities are represented in Urbancrest's future.

#### Developing the Vision: Goals and Actions

Goals and actions are necessary to achieve the vision. The process can be thought of as taking a vacation.

The **vision** is the vacation, and the **goals** are the stops along the way: your home, airport, and lodg-ing.

The **actions** are the routes we must take to get to each destination.

All of the plan's goals have several action steps that will move Urbancrest forward to achieve the Village's visions.

#### Building the Future: Land Use and Development

The land use and development goals and actions will guide how Urbancrest looks and functions in the future.



**Renovate** vacant and run-down properties.



Residential/commercial design standards.



New development is **pedestrian-oriented**.



Ensure **diverse housing** types are built.

## Moving Forward: Transportation Infrastructure

The transportation goals and actions aim to expand ease and safety for all modes of getting around. All users must be safely accommodated.

The goals and actions for community and housing intend to bring new and current residents together and create pride in the community.

The parks and green space goals and actions will ensure that current and future residents have enough space to walk and bike outdoors.

Develop a **greenbelt** across the road from the railroad tracks on Augustus Street.



Build **biking infrastructure** throughout the Village.
